Following are projects that we are especially proud of and what your membership dues support:

- \* "Images of America: Purcellville," a 240+ page collection of photographs and history published with Arcadia.
- \* Our annual Heritage Day where, together with townspeople, businesses and organizations, the PPA showcases our town's rich history in a day long festival with local music, a wine garden, local restaurants and caterers, crafts, arts, childrens games, animal programs, films and tours.
- \* The Vintage Home & Garden Tour in the Town of Purcellville.
- \* Our first restoration project, the move and reassembly of the Mahlon-Taylor Springhouse as you enter town limits on the east end of Purcellville.
- \* The renovation of the Purcellville Train Station with the Town's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee that now serves the Town of Purcellville.
- \* Our Historic Plaque Program that recognizes historic properties throughout Purcellville.
- \* Our oral history film "The Stories Behind the Story of Purcellville," produced by members of the PPA with townspeople sharing precious legacies, community traditions and intimate memories of our town over the last century, capturing information about Purcellville's past before it disappears. DVDs are available for purchase at all events where the PPA is participating.
- \* Our Christmas Ornament Program with charming brass replicas of old Purcellville.
- \* The commemorative Town Clock in front of the Magnolia's Restaurant on 21st Street in memory of a special friend and preservationist, Bruce Brownell, that the PPA helped make happen.
- \* Every September, the PPA plays a vital role in the Emancipation Celebration near the Emancipation Grounds in Purcellville.
- \* Historic walking tours (brochures for self-guided tours are available at the Town Hall, Purcellville Library, Visit Loudoun and on our website).
